Winter Reminders

A reminder about the importance of dressing appropriately for winter weather and the guidelines for outdoor recess.

1. Dress in Layers:

Please ensure that your child is dressed in layers to stay warm and comfortable during outdoor activities. We recommend the following items:

- A warm coat
- · Gloves or mittens
- Hat or scarf
- Thermal or wool socks
- Boots (for snow and wet conditions)
- Snow pants (if necessary)

2. Proper Footwear

As the weather can be wet and icy, please ensure that your child wears boots to school on snowy days. They should also bring a pair of indoor shoes to change into during the day.

3. Outdoor Recess

Students will go outside for recess unless the temperature or wind chill is dangerously low. In such cases, we will adjust or shorten outdoor playtime to ensure students' safety and well-being. If your child is not feeling well enough to participate in outdoor recess, please keep them at home until they are fully recovered.
