Safe entry and exit procedures

To ensure safety for all BFPS community members, while mitigating traffic, it is strongly recommended that you exit our parking lot by turning right. If needed, please use the roundabout at Tower Hill Road to proceed in the opposite direction.

To ensure student safety, please, refrain from coming onto the tarmac during drop-off and pick ups.

Please note:

- Aside from the Kiss 'N Ride area, there is no parking alongside sidewalks in the parking lot at Beynon Fields. Kiss 'n Ride area is a drop-off area where the drivers remain in the vehicle while the students get out of the car. Drop-off should occur on the sidewalk side for safety reasons. Drivers are welcome to use the parking spots if they wish to accompany the child;
- Refrain from parking next to pylons- they are placed to support safety for our families in no-parking zones;
- In the morning, parking is available on a short-term basis, and can take place on the south side of Stockbridge Avenue. To maintain safety, you are encouraged not to park on the north side of Stockbridge Avenue.
- Adhere to signs posted at the bus entrance to the school. Buses require a certain distance to enter the bus loop safely. Cars are not to park close to the entrance to the bus loop.
- To maintain safety for all. There is no pick up at the end of the day on Stockbridge Avenue (north of school).

School Council

As parents/guardians, participation in school council is one way to be engaged in your child's learning experience. Our first school council nomination meeting is tentatively scheduled at 7:10pm on September 25, 2024, in the school library. This will follow the *Meet the Teacher Night* tentatively scheduled for 6pm also on the same night. More information on School Council to follow.
