Meeting your BCSS OSSD requirements:

- 30 credits minimum (18 compulsories + 12 electives)
- Literacy: OSSLT or OLC4O, 80 Community Involvement hours , 6 HPE credits
- BCSS Graduation 2018 Thursday, June 21

Meeting the entrance requirements for programs of interest:

- Ontario Universities
 - 6 courses with 4U or 4M codes, including ENG4U.
 - Courses listed as "required" for each program of interest.
 - Calculation of admission average will include required courses + next highest marks for a total of 6.
- Ontario Colleges
 - ENG4C, plus "required" courses as listed by each school/program.
 - Look for "other" requirements (i.e. portfolio, interview, tests...)
