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Think Pink...

This week, on **Wednesday, February 26th**, our school joined along with schools across Canada in celebrating <u>Pink Shirt Day</u>. Pink Shirt Day provides schools with an opportunity to raise awareness on the topic of bullying. Of all the issues we deal with as a school, bullying is one of the most volatile and delicate. The reasons for this can be rhymed off by most of us, parents educators and students- bullying in all forms causes real and lasting harm and impacts both children and their families.

Bullying is an issue in schools- just as bullying is an issue in our society. Schools are just a microcosm of our communities; with one important difference, of course. Unlike our communities, in schools our children mingle and co-exist in close proximity, grouped by age with adult supervision that is different than they experience in their families and homes. It is in our public schools that our children receive their earliest impressions of what the 'real world' is all about; the struggles, joys, despair, triumph, cruelty, justice and injustice- all played out on a daily basis in our classrooms, hallways and school yard.

We all have, as a goal, the elimination of bullying. But this goal is both complex and demanding- and achieving it will require that we have lots of caring adults who make empathy and inclusion the focus of our schools and teach effective conflict resolution. Bullying can be seen as an example of the absence of empathy- the cold, hard application of 'me first' and the individuals involved (the aggressor and the target) are both harmed by the acts of bullying. We know that to effectively address bullying we need to help children understand their feelings, words and actions and the impact they have on others.

Learning how to respect differences and be kind to others is a big part of the work that we do with our students, not just on Pink Shirt Day but every day.
