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## Thinking About Special Education...

Later this month will have the opportunity to co-host the grade 8 to grade 9 IPRC meetings for our grade 8 students. This is an important part of the journey students make towards high school graduation, especially for our students with special education needs. Special education is a key area of focus; for the Ministry of Education, for our board, for our school and most importantly; for our students and families. The Ministry of Education has specific categories related to special education identifications.

Here at Black River, **1 of every 4 students** has been formally identified with some form of special education need- that's over 60 kids. The majority of these students have been identified with some form of a learning disability; some have been placed on the autism spectrum, while the remaining children are identified either a physical or behavioral exceptionality- such as ADHD or anxiety.

Over the past 20 years there has been an impressive amount of brain research that has had a profound impact on how we program for students with exceptionalities. As a school we are working to incorporate this research into our practice. We provide a wide range of interventions and supports to students with special education needs. We provide teaching and environmental accommodations to address specific learning needs, we use assistive technology tools (like <u>Dreambox</u> and Google Read/Write) to help close gaps in learning and enable students to access the curriculum. We offer intervention programs (like Reading Recovery™ and our student support centres and community classes) to ensure that those students who have significant needs are given the intensive intervention they require. We believe that schools should be places where every child has the right to learn; regardless of how they learn or the challenges they face.
