Parent/Teacher Conferences...a reminder that families may book a conference time to discuss their child's progress through EDSBY. **Progress Reports...**Progress Reports will be shared with families *after parent teacher conferences* on **November 19th and 20th**. As was the case last June, the reports will be shared with families using our secure, electronic document sharing system. Please make sure you (or your child) is aware of how to access their YRDSB GAPPS email account- your child's teacher will be able to help with this information if required.

**Transportation & Inclement Weather...** with the arrival of winter weather on the horizon, families are reminded to monitor local media outlines, School Bus City and/or the board's Twitter feed, @YRDSB, for up to date information on inclement weather and the impact it may have on bus transportation.

Virtual Ukulele Club...with the support of our Black River School Council we have struck up a partnership with Connors Music in Keswick to provide ukulele lessons as part of our virtual ukulele club. The lessons will be offered remotely, during the lunch break, using video conferencing software with no cost to students. An initial 6-week long session will be offered to our grade 4-8 students (a limit of 20 students) with a second 6 week session offered to our gr. 1-3 students later in the school year. A letter with a line to the Ukulele Club Registration Survey will be emailed to families next week. Spaces will be offered to the first 20 applicants and the school will provide a loaner ukulele to those students who are unable to purchase their own instrument.
