### Remembering & Connecting...

An important part of the role that public schools play is helping children understand the important stories and traditions of their community, connect these stories to their daily lives and open their minds to the world as it is-and as it could be. The first two weeks of November provide an opportunity to experience a few important Canadian traditions and explore some stories from through new eyes and perspectives.

This coming Monday we will honour the contributions that our military personnel have made, both in the past and present, at our **Remembrance Day** observation. Our students and community members will welcome honoured guests from the **Royal Canadian Legion**; to learn about the importance of remembrance of the times of war and provide our students with the chance to ask questions and build their awareness of the contributions our military men and women make here at home and around the world. Students will participate in a moment of silence, the last post and lay a wreath of poppies to honour the fallen. We wish to thank **Andrew Halstead** and his **grade 8 students** for the time and effort and leadership they put into organizing this important event.

In addition, over the past week our classes learned about and acknowledged <u>Treaties Recognition Week</u> in Ontario. Recognizing that the land we occupy has been the home to Indigenous peoples for thousands of years prior to European colonization is important. Equally important is helping our students make connections between the events and challenges of the past and how we can reconcile and redefine our Canadian society for the future. As part of the learning, we welcomed storyteller **Gail Johnston** from our partners on **Georgina Island** on Friday morning to work with our grade 1 to 5 students and share the rich oral traditions of our treaty partners and connect these traditions with the world we live in today.
