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Halloween...

As the end of the month approaches and Halloween creeps up on us, I would like to share the happy news that Halloween will not be a victim of the COVID-19 pandemic! Though we will have to make a few alterations to how we celebrate this calendar event- we are delighted that we will be able to do so this year.

As we would with a school-hosted Halloween event in any school year; we do want to address an issue that relates directly to the well being and safety of our students. We remind parents that we have children as young as three years old in our school and expect that any costumes that are worn at school will not portray characters that are too violent, frightening or have replica weapons. We also respect the cultural practices of all our families and wish to note that these considerations will be included as decisions are made about classroom celebrations. Costumes that depict cultural groups do not reflect the goals we have set to make all our students feel they belong and are respected-regardless of their cultural heritage. Together with Public Health we have developed the following protocols to ensure that our Halloween celebrations will be safe for us all:

- → Celebrations will be held in the classroom only (no parades) and teachers will inform parents of the time and nature of the celebration
- → Teachers may permit students to bring their costumes to school to wear; costume masks will not be permitted- if your child's costume includes a costume mask please do not send it to school with your child
- → Students will continue to follow our existing COVID-19 protocols (protective masks, hand sanitizing and physical distancing)
- → Parents will not be asked to provide any snack or food items to share with classmates- teachers may provide packaged treats

We know this won't be a typical Halloween-it is 2020 after all. We do hope that our students and families will embrace the spirit of this celebration in spite of the challenges and make the most of it. As a minimum, it should serve as an interesting Halloween memory to this most fascinating of school years!
