### Safe@School...

Next week has been designated **Safety Week** in schools across York Region. Over the course of the week in our classrooms and across the school we will engage in some activities to raise student awareness of safety and ways that they can ensure that they make choices that keep them safe- both in school and in the community. We will hold fire and school lockdown drills during the week and continue to remind our students about our <u>Caring and Safe Schools</u> policy and school behaviour expectations.

Of course we don't just focus on safety with our students during safety week; ensuring that we work to keep our students safe at school is a daily focus for us. Across the curriculum our staff focus on a wide range of topics like bullying awareness and prevention, the risks of substance abuse and safe use of online tools and social media. We also work closely with our community partners from the York Region Police, Georgina Fire & Rescue and York Region EMS; both with educational programs as wells as direct support and involvement when required. I am impressed and proud of the commitment that our staff have to student safety; we make sure we are visible in the halls and in the yard and address concerns and issues when they arise. We also appreciate the support that our parents and community partners continue to provide when issues do arise.

Our schools are actually very safe places; between St. Bernadette's and Black River, we have almost 500 children in our building every day with very few safety issues and when incidents do occur, we have trained and skilled adults to ensure that the incidents are addressed appropriately and our students understand that the adults are here to help them. Ultimately, we all want the same thing- a caring and safe learning environment where every child has a sense of belonging, feels safe and is learning.
