**School Cash Online...**A reminder to families new to our community that we use a board-provided web-based payment system called School Cash Online to process all school-related transactions (field trips, pizza sales). **EDSBY..** All schools in the YRDSB now use a secure online parent communication and engagement platform called EDSBY. EDSBY is also used to manage student attendance- parents who have activated their account can even enter their child's absence using the EDSBY app (which means no more phone calls to report an absence). We are learning how to use the communication features of this tool to support effective and secure parent teacher communication and will be using EDSBY to schedule parent teacher interviews this coming November.
