

Student Dress Code

Attending school is an important activity. All students are expected to dress in a manner that contributes to the learning atmosphere. Your manner of dress affects the tone at school and reflects how you think about yourself. Each student is expected to come to school appropriately attired for classroom learning. Black River will follow these dress code details:

- All tank tops straps must have a two finger width minimum and no gaping sides
- No undergarments exposed at any time
- Tops and bottoms must connect at the mid-section
- Short/skirt length must be mid-thigh length range
- No objectionable or offensive words, signs, or images on clothing

In addition to the above guidelines, all clothing worn must be deemed appropriate by school Administration. Students who are not appropriately dressed will be required to change offending clothing items or cover them with another piece of clothing. Should a student refuse to comply with the above, parents will have to pick their child up so that he/she may go home to change.
