Admin Report – Vivienne Baines

- Focus on next school year planning. Number of students, classroom organization.
- Junior girls' and boys' volleyball is wrapping up.
- Robotics team competition in February.
- Play leaders are helping the primary students with games during tarmac recess.
- At times the field is off limits due to ice in winter and mud in spring. Tarmac recess is necessary, should the field be damaged, it could be off limits for up to a year for repairs.
