Bogart Staff Survey (Alex):

Survey sent to all staff from the school council and 25 responded. Here are the summaries.

Top needed items are:

Chromebooks, subsidizing school events and E-Learning Subscriptions.

Teacher expressed that if the council could allocate a fixed amount for each classroom where staff could decide what supplies, they need.

Here are some ideas for items to donate to class

- Board games (Connect 4,chess, checkers, Trouble, Snakes and Ladders, Jr Scrabble, Jr Boggle, Other Word Games, Dominos, etc.), deck cards, puzzles
- Sports equipment (skates, basketballs, foam snow sleds, skipping ropes, etc.)
- Books (picture, chapter books, dual lingual, etc.)
- Musical instruments (Yamaha, Makalo, Mahalo, Ukulele, etc.)
- Lego, building blocks, linking logs, or other building toys (Kinex, Duplo, wooden blocks)
- Tissue, calming sensory items, sidewalk chalk, school supplies (pencil, crayons, markers, construction paper, glue, etc.), paper organizers (bankers box sorting, portable shelves, etc.),
 Craft supplies
- Dolls, puppets, play dough, toy cars/trucks, decodable readers

- Music stands
- Scientist in the Classroom, Mathletes, Coding or STEM activities

- Kindergarten outside toys and activities (Buckets and shovels for the sandbox, chalk, balls, soccer nets or short basketball hoops)
