MINUTES FROM LAST MEETING

TREASURER'S REPORT

- balance is about \$2k as of today
- donation money to be deposited (approx. \$550); can immediately transfer \$
- pizza funds will be coming in
- any other straggler donations as a result of the donation letter? not sure, Principal has to check
 - are we good w/ the Treasurer report? (no report but verbal discussion)
 - discussion approved

PAST ACTION ITEMS

- general thank you for donations in newsletter: Co-Chair Chan submitted SC update to Principal and it was included
- Co-Chair Chan sent out pizza term 2 forms for January
- since we've decided to put fundraising via Booster Juice on hold, will maybe try it in February
- Principal is to email parents advising they can still make donations (in the Happy Holidays email)
- Principal is to provide updated chart to see where we are in terms of technology (i.e. how many computers do we have) a current list of what we have in the building (what's operational—what does not need to be replaced—and what's coming)
 - o NB: Principal ordered another 7 Chromebooks yesterday @ full price through school funds

BOXWOOD PUBLIC SCHOOL

- funds for jerseys paid by Principal from school funds can now be transferred back to school account from SC
- Boxwood's science lab needs
 - we need an assessment on whether new science lab equipment is needed (and, if so, what is needed)so SC can discussing funding (Principal is to talk to science teachers to get SC a list)

FUNDRAISING

- pizza:
 - pizza volunteers have said they are selling out of pizza so another pizza to be ordered
 - forms for term 2 pizza were sent out yesterday (parents asked to return them by Tuesday giving them a full week to order pizza)
 - this order has 11 weeks (previous order and next order = 12 weeks)
 - parents don't have to return the envelope (Principal will send an email: reminder pizza orders for term 2 are due tomorrow and no need to return envelopes)
 - Math Night
 - o March 2017
 - how we can leverage math night and the traffic there? perhaps we can fundraise during Math Night (fundraising that is theme appropriate)?
 - o letter to provide vendors soliciting donations should not be a problem (per Principal)
 - o brainstorming for Math Night
 - set up booth? sell raffle tickets or math manipulates?
 - we can need to work out the logistics
 - prizes can be given out
 - can we sell raffle tickets? this should be OK (did this on Bingo night in a previous school year)
 - cannot do 50/50
 - discussed possibility of vendor attending school, selling their products and providing school with a percentage of profits and/or sponsor event/donate a monetary amount
 - Mr. Chin (Boxwood's VP last school year) sourced out math games for last year's Math Night (Principal will follow-up)
 - school/math supply store (where schools buy resources): Victoria Park/McNicoll (Principal will find out location)
 - couple of nice, big ticket items as prizes? Monopoly, Lego sets, etc.
 - vendor booth?
 - sales promotion: portion of sales revenue being provided to school? Secretary to speak with vendor and update during January meeting (to canvass vendor on how to approach fundraising and provide update to SC)

SOCIAL MEDIA UPDATE

- TELUS WISE session w/ a TW Ambassador
 - o free!
 - Co-Chair Chan sent some questions to contact and is getting answers and details (content, age range/grade range? can parents attend? one seminar? how long is a typical visit? schedule and are they booking for the new year?)
 - NB: they have an agreement with TDSB
 - o covers internet and using social media, how to be safe, how to protect yourself
 - o they give a little booklet away with safety tips
 - iPad prize: schools get a chance to win an iPad + free seminar (again, Co-Chair Chan will have more info)
 - if we go with TELUS WISE, will not pursue Shapelle option
- if we have a parent presentation, can we host it during a SC meeting? TBD wait for update from Co-Chair Chan

ADMINISTRATION UPDATE

- Cost Sharing order has not arrived; new order (separate from CS, @ full price) was put in this week
- Synrevoice launched this month
 - \circ $\$ had to support a few parents to use the technology but it's going well
 - o per Secretary: it's great that parents are sent an email when student absence is reported
- staff meeting looked @ EQAO samples and had discussion
 - o Grade 3 and 6 students very well versed in EQAO; other grade teachers had an opportunity to look at it
 - teachers were photocopying EQAO materials
 - o have a Google folder where all the assessments are available in a folder
 - also looked at grade 9 assessments and grade 10 assessments so teachers can see the type of questions their students will face when they leave Boxwood
- report card and parent teacher interviews: very good and some parents were contacted over phone
- lots of teams and clubs happening
 - o Knitting Club
 - Lego Robotics Club being run by Ms. Calverley (they are preparing for the Ontario Skills Competition, open to YRDSB and no cost to enter competition)
 - per Member Dogra: since cost for FSL competition is \$900 (NB: another competition), why don't we have a competition within the school?
 - we have enough sets, we have the guidelines from previous years on what needs to be built, it involves the students and it'll be cost free
 - per Member Dogra: MDH students can come in to help out with the competition
 - this will allow more students to participate and will be a great prep for the FSL competition, should the school decide to enter it in the future (so, a byproduct of the in house competition is that those kids who move on to the international competition or the ON one are going to be more prepared)
 - if the school is really interested, there are scholarships available (going forward)
 - NB: distinction b/w Lego Mechanics and Lego Robotics
 - \circ ~ no ski club since Ms. Brown isn't here
 - Dec 14 and 15 school concerts
 - Dec 16 food drive ends
 - Dec 23 ugly holiday sweater Friday
 - Dec 23 annual holiday singalong
 - Jan 9 back to school

HEATING IN THE BUILDING

- Treasurer discussed heating in the building
- Ms. Breckenridge's room is cold (b/w 20 and 23) per thermostat @ 19.5/20
- zonal thermostat or one thermostat? whole building has one
- who normally takes care of it? caretaker
- have put in a call; NB: the temperatures are within the required range (within the acceptable ranges), though students and teacher note that it's cold
- per Principal: different rooms in the school have varying temperatures
- there is no AC in the building
- since the heating consistency is still within acceptable ranges, nothing additional can be done (a block heater cannot be used due to fire hazard issues)
