## Treasurer's Report:

- Opening Balance \$7 399.44
- Closing Balance \$10 718.78
- Pizza lunch revenue line item to be adjusted to \$5 579 (from \$5 616.45)
- BINA to work with Heather for pizza collection breakdown
- Adjust Grade 8 graduation future expense slotted in June to \$900 (from \$1000) as less Grade 8 students this year
- Members in attendance approved report

### **Administration Update:**

- SIP still need to embed Parent Council piece
  - Catherine to add planned Parent Council goals, activities and initiatives already supported to SIP template
  - Review next meeting and discuss more ideas if any
- Science Lab Equipment Funding inventory of existing equipment is complete (detailed list provided with breakdown of quantity and cost per equipment line item)
  - \$3 000 cost to restock lab to capacity and replace broken, worn out and outdated equipment
  - Priority is electricity equipment
  - ASK: \$2 000 support from Parent Council and Catherine to cover \$1 000
  - o Members in attendance agreed to support this and approved the spend
- **Pizza Lunch Fridays** additional plates needed have been replenished based on costing provided by Pranab
- Subway Lunches Council moving forward with decision to trial subway lunch Wednesdays from Feb 11 to Apr 8
  - o 6 choices of 6 inch sub to choose from for \$3.50 each
  - Sub only, no drink or combos
- **Technology Update** Mr. Prince reviewed the benefits of the Board Cost Sharing model to level set for everyone why it is the most productive program to meet the school's technology goals
  - York Region Board is the only board that offers this cost sharing program
  - Board match ratio aligns with the school population i.e. more students enrolled, the better the match ratio
  - A vendor selection process is indeed used to select the vendors on the Board's approved list to purchase from (Apple and Dell are both approved technology vendors)
  - Purchasing through this program includes warranty and maintenance with convenient onsite support/repair
  - Tech Lead per school's input is taken into consideration
  - Next Cost Sharing opportunity is in the Spring with a \$2 000 max match
  - Boxwood would like to make better use of the iPad tablets as students currently gravitate to using laptops
    - To do this, ask to purchase wireless keyboards to use with iPads
    - Do wireless keyboards make iPads a first choice amongst students in the classroom?
    - Mr. Prince will pilot this in one class
    - Parent Council agreed to supporting this trial
    - If proves successful, we can discuss purchasing additional wireless keyboards
