Previous Meeting's Minutes

• Previous meeting minutes from September 23, 2013, first meeting of 2012/13 school year, reviewed and adopted by all attendees

Treasurer's Report (provided by school for this meeting)

- Opening Balance \$3 870.82
- Closing Balance \$8 298.93
- Tas needs last spreadsheet

Technology Presentation (Brad McQuirter, Boxwood Technology Program Lead)

- Presenting using Tech carts; each cart includes LCD projector, speakers, sub woofers, laptop to use with projector and 5 mobile laptops
- Philosophy of program is putting technology in hands of students in each classroom
- 5 laptops are a specific model which are easy to stack
- These complement the desktop computers in each classroom (8 in intermediate, 5 in junior)
- YouTube video the promotes "blended" learning i.e. partnering face-to-face and learning using the computer
- Evolution to smaller and more portable, also use of "Clouds" to store information which enables greater accessibility
- Boxwood goal is to have a tech cart in every classroom with a document camera (projects images onto a large screen)

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- All classrooms equipped with whiteboards that Boxwood can leverage and would like to move towards a more interactive Smart Board method e.g. Mimio teach bar and rechargeable stylus (Mimios are currently not part of cost sharing program but will be)
- Tools with an internet connection gives classrooms access to a whole new level of interactive learning tools e.g. Tagxedo, Moodle, Desire to Learn, Google Docs and Apps
- School Improvement Plan (SIP) can be shared with Council after Catherine presents to Board
- Cost sharing ratio this year is 1:1.5 i.e. for every computer we buy, Board will supply 1.5 computer
 - o Better to get application in so school can benefit this year in a timely manner and not

Technology Related Discussion

- Each cart costs approx. \$2 300 total (\$1500 + \$800 doc cam), laptops to complete carts already on hand in the school (Catherine/Brad to follow-up)
- Napinder questioning Bring Your Own Device program currently being piloted in Mr. Sharma and Ms. Royce's classrooms
 - o Agreement that parents are being asked to sign seems strictly a waiving of liability
 - Accessible content and websites are managed via the school WIFI and network i.e. only school approved websites that enable and support learning are accessible
- Claudia saying moodle being used but may not be easiest to use or being used appropriately by students
 - Are there now too many tools? Tech tools and websites seem to be replacing the agenda making it difficult for parents to keep track of what students are doing and how they are
 - supposed to be used
- Claudia brought up concern that using this level of technology could potentially create a 2 tier learning system differentiating students by income level; this is concerning and not every parent will agree with this
- Requesting communication to parents not only about hardware but also the software so parents are knowledgeable, not left behind and are able to understand and support student learning at home
- A lot of good discussion, especially around software, guidelines and parent awareness. We can revisit this another time (assignment TBD)
- Move forward with purchasing decision while we also move in parallel with putting together strategy, guidelines and addressing technology for students of all backgrounds
- Put onus on each teacher to follow a specific communication strategy to send home to parents
