Course Change ProceduresStudent Activity Fee:

This fee supports the school breakfast program, student groups, Student Council and Event Council activities (i.e. dances, movie night, Bossilicious, Carnival), grade 9 day BBQ, student celebrations, athletic transportation, clubs, councils, and guest speakers. These activities build a sense of community and belonging.

The cost to participate in many events and athletic teams will be decreased based on the payment of this student activity fee.

The student activity fee also offsets the cost of student printing. Students will receive 40 pages of printing each semester (subsequent pages are at the cost of \$0.10 / page)

Camp Robin Hood:

New this year, all grade 9s will be participating in a day of leadership and team building activities on September 20, 2019. This day is specifically designed for our grade 9 students to help them in their transition to high school. The focus of the day is developing leadership and cooperative skills, and building bonds and trust with new friends. Camp activities will be led by Camp Robin Staff supported by a trained group of BOSS mentors from grades 10 to 12 and supervised by BOSS grade 9 teachers. Fees include all camp activities, lunch, transportation and a grade 9 t'shirt. Students will leave school at 8:15 AM and return for 2:55 PM. Students will receive their camp day shirt on September 3 and must also wear it for Camp Day.
