NEW MODEL FOR SEMESTER 1 - FALL 2021

Student Timetable Structure

Students will be regularly scheduled into 4 courses per semester with 2 courses running per day for a full day for 1 week with the other 2 courses running in alternating weeks. This daily structure may resemble a quad but occurs over a full semester. It allows for a potential shift to a four-period daily schedule should conditions change during the school year based on ministry requirements.
