



- Students not involved in in person learning will be working on asynchronous learning tasks at home
- Students are able to remain at school in their cohorts to participate in study hall on their school days only. Study hall is designed to support
 students by providing them with a space in the school in which to participate in their synchronous online learning. Students will have to sign up
 for study to allow cohort grouping and contact tracing.

STUDY HALL

- Study Hall is available for students who do not have consistent access to wifi at home and are in school that day for their in-person morning class.
- Students are required to stay for lunch and work on afternoon online courses while being supervised by a staff member.
- Students are required to sign up for Study Hall ahead of time through teach assist to allow for cohort grouping.




STRUCTURE AND RULES
