Past President's Scholarship 2020 Application Form

Four (4) Scholarships are awarded annually. One first place winner from each of the two (2) essay topics (see 4 a. below) will be awarded \$5,000.00 each, and one second place winner from each of the same two (2) essay topics (see 4 a. below) will be awarded \$2,500.00 each, for a grand total of \$15,000.00 annually.

Eligibility Requirements

- This scholarship is applicable to students in their final year of an Ontario secondary school who are pursuing post-secondary education after graduation, for example, college, university, or a trade school. Students must currently reside in the province of Ontario and be registered with a secondary school within the province. Applicants must also be a Canadian citizen or have been given permanent resident status. Applicants applying to a post-secondary school outside of Ontario (or even Canada), are still eligible for the scholarship.

- 3) Applicants must have a record of academic achievement and possess a range of leadership qualities and community involvement experience.
- 4) Applicants must complete the Personal Information section (Page 3) of this application form, and submit it together with the following documents:
 - a. A written essay (minimum of 1500 words, typed and double-spaced) on one of the following subjects:
 - i. Housing is changing. From a greater market share for condos, to laneway homes and tiny houses, today's homeowners and renters have different needs and different realities. What do you think the future of housing looks like and why?
 - ii. The housing market in core areas have left home buyers feeling priced out. What factors do you think could address housing affordability across the GTA? Choose one or two issues to focus on. Examples include:
 - · improved transit and transportation networks
 - improved first-time buyer incentives and tax breaks
 - speculation or vacancy tax levies.

If applicable, citations must be present; however, they are not included in the word count. The style of citation is your choice, for example, MLA or APA.

IMPORTANT NOTE: In order to facilitate the judging process, please **DO NOT** include any personal information, for example, your name and email address, on the individual essay pages (on the optional cover page is fine).

- b. A detailed resume outlining academic achievements, work experience, volunteer work, and extracurricular activities.
- c. Two (2) brief letters of reference (including current contact information for each reference). The resume and letters of reference may be in paragraph, chart, bullet point, etc., format.

- d. A current academic transcript from all secondary schools attended. (Photocopies or scans of transcripts are sufficient as they will not be returned.)
- e. A photocopy or scan of offer(s) of admission to a post-secondary institution(s).
- 5) You may enter one essay for each topic; however, one person cannot be awarded more than one scholarship. Duplicate and incomplete submissions will not be considered. If you are submitting an essay for each topic, only one application is required. All application materials must be submitted in one email/mailing/drop off. (Email submissions will receive a one-time confirmation.) Submissions can be individual PDFs or Word documents, or one file, for example, a single PDF. **NOTE:** Please do not submit your documents as links.
- 6) All answers must be submitted in English. Answers in other languages will not be read or considered.
- 7) All contact information including applicant and secondary school names will be removed from all documentation presented to the judges; however, per 5) above, we ask that you **do not** include personal information on the individual essay pages (on the optional cover page is fine).
- 8) Only the four (4) scholarship award recipients will be contacted via telephone *before* June 1, 2020 concerning the status of their application. All other applicants will be contacted via email *after* June 1, 2020.
- 9) A scholarship award of \$5,000.00/not to exceed \$5,000.00 will be paid to each first place award recipient and a scholarship award of \$2,500.00/not to exceed \$2,500.00 will be paid to each second place award recipient prior to the start of the first semester of post-secondary studies.
- 10) The decision of the judges is final and is not subject to an appeal.
- 11) Please note that if any information provided by the applicant is determined by The Toronto Regional Real Estate Board to be inaccurate or misleading, The Toronto Regional Real Estate Board may cancel or revoke any grant, if awarded, in its sole discretion and the applicant will be required to reimburse The Toronto Regional Real Estate Board for the full amount of the grant, if paid.
- 12) Recipients of the scholarship awards must agree to:
 - Sign a use and disclosure consent form, and/or provide consent via an email to:
 - Permit the use of their name/image/essay/secondary school name, etc., to be used for promotional purposes by The Toronto Regional Real Estate Board; and,
 - Freely participate in up to six (6) hours of promotional events on behalf of The Toronto Regional Real Estate Board.

PERSONAL INFORMATION

Although your social insurance number is not required in order to consider your application, we may request that you provide this information to the Toronto Regional Real Estate Board in the event that you are selected to receive the scholarship, at which time, The Toronto Regional Real Estate Board may be required to report the award to Canada Revenue Agency (CRA).
