





 - If you don't choose alternates then we choose for you!





Course Levels - Grade 9


Course type	Details
DESTREAMED	 Math, Science, English and Geography maximum class size currently 25.
ACADEMIC	 French as well as Grade 10 Science, Math and History maximum class size of 29
LOCALLY DEVELOPED	 may be offered in the following compulsory courses: Science, Math, English, History maximum class size of 16 placement determined through an IPRC meeting
OPEN	 offered in the following compulsory courses: French, Physical Education, Arts, Civics/Careers and all remaining grade 9&10 electives maximum class size of 29 (exception Technology courses)


Math Science English Geography **Physical Education** is the same for all students. Gender Specific or Coed

- Once submitted your selection will be locked
- Your Grade 8 Transition Teacher will lead you through myBlueprint and how to select and submit your courses

Reminders:

- All grade 9 students take 8 courses
- Select:
 - 6 compulsory
 - •2 electives
 - •2 alternatives
- ELLs need to select 2 English credits (ex. ESLB & ESLC)
- Students with IEP may want Learning Strategies.
- If you choose vocal or instrumental music, you need to decide about AMR (9th credit)



2 mandatory E-Learning Courses

- These courses can be chosen
 - during your grade 11 / 12 year in day school or
 - Certain Grade 10 summer school course

Mandatory E-Learning
