## High School Schedule

- School year is split into two semesters

## Course Levels - Grade 9

| Course type | Details |
| :---: | :---: |
| DESTREAMED | - Math, Science, English and Geography <br> - maximum class size currently 25. |
| ACADEMIC | - French as well as Grade 10 Science, Math and History <br> - maximum class size of 29 |
| LOCALLY DEVELOPED | - may be offered in the following compulsory courses: Science, Math, English, History <br> - maximum class size of 16 <br> - placement determined through an IPRC meeting |
| OPEN | - offered in the following compulsory courses: <br> French, Physical Education, Arts, Civics/Careers and all remaining grade 9\&10 electives <br> - maximum class size of 29 (exception Technology courses) |
