

After Exams.....Averages?


Earn your marks and keep the published average/conditions to offer

Gowns

- Gowns will be distributed TODAY after this assembly at the appropriate station by LAST NAME.
- Teachers and volunteers who hand out the gowns, please have the students initial that graduates have received their gown, vee stole and tassel

Preparation of Gown

- Steam gown or iron on low heat
- Vee-stole
- Attach tassel to the cap it goes on your LEFT

Dress Code - What to Wear

- Dark colors: navy, black or gray
- Dress pants, skirt or dress
- Blouse, dress top, dress shirt, tie
- Wear dress shoes that are comfortable and that you can walk up and down stairs

Dress Code - What to Avoid

- Shorts
- Flip flops, running shoes, heavy boots
- Shoes you can't walk in
- Hairstyle that makes your cap fall off
- Suit jackets it's too hot!
- Carrying your purse or phone on stage--leave with a guest



- Recessional


Lining Up for Procession

- Grads will follow the platform party


Processional: Entering the Gymnasium (cued to enter)




Receiving Your Diploma - Group 1

Get Ready for the Show

- Students announced <u>from their</u> name card
- Individual will have name read
- Go across the stage
- Each student will stop to receive ceremonial diploma and shake hands

On Stage Performance

"Shake, Take and Go Strategy"

 PLEASE do not take away from the seriousness of evening by "making a dramatic entrance or exit"

Smile for the Camera

- NO posed pictures on stage during diploma presentations (by your family)
- professional photographer takes your picture when you shake hands on stage
- Best pictures can be taken before or after the ceremony with family and friends

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

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
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
