


What levels should I take in Grade 10?





Grades 7 - 12 Individual Pathways Plan



Summer School

 Reinforcement: designed for students who have failed a course in Grade 9 and need to recover it--2 weeks in July. This is only offered for certain courses.

OR

- Acceleration: there may be a recommendation that you repeat the whole course (need to repeat at BOSS)
- Other courses taken at summer school must be <u>pre-approved</u> by the Guidance Department and the Principal
- Registration will begin in April/May listen for announcements

Summer School

- If you are thinking about taking a summer school, you still **MUST** choose it on your course selection as summer school is not guaranteed.
