- Buttonville PS Section B Proposed Boundary change Presented by Trina & Kathryn
 - Background in Fall 2023, the Board submitted a capital project request to the Ministry of Education to construct a new elementary school on the former York Downs Golf Course.
 - The school site is located northwest of 16th Avenue and Kennedy Rd in the current Buttonville PS Section B Boundary
 - o Proposed opening date is September 2028
 - All Residential units within the Buttonville PS Section B boundary can not be accommodated at Buttonville PS long term.

Timing and Student Impact

- There is no immediate impact on existing students at this time. Students in the block will continue to attend Buttonville PS.
- The Board has not yet received approval for the capital project request submitted to the Ministry of Education in Fall 2023.

- Summary of Financials as of February 22, 2024:
 - Started the school year with \$16,507 and as of February 22, 2024, we have \$21,947;
 total profit \$5,440
 - 40% of lunch profits totaled \$4,369 (Pizza \$2008 + Sub \$909 + Astoria Greek \$667 + Ambiyan \$507 + Booster Juice \$168 + Kome \$111)
 - o \$261 profit from popcorn and hot chocolate sales
 - \$105 profit from cotton candy (this is profit against the total purchased; however, against the 357 tubs sold, the profit is \$470)
