## COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

### 1. INTRODUCTION & SCHOOL NEWS

- Minutes of last meeting on April 17<sup>th</sup>, 2019 were approved.
- Ms. Henry presented school news with Band won gold
- Badminton tournament and successful Grandparents tea
- Design thinking project, 8 schools was elected to paint portraits of themselves
- June 10<sup>th</sup> – Track and Field
- EQOA happening right now and Spring concert coming up
- Preparation for next school year from school budget (updates from Asha): Gym equipment topped up, flexible seating, music equipment

### 2. FINANCE & TREASURERS REPORT

- \$1,500 went out for flexible seating
- Parent donation through the board of \$97 received
- All inclusive bracelets 125 quantity x \$16 = \$2000 approximate
- \$1,817.50 for Summer BBQ estimated costs
- Tent coming out for approximately \$1,800 estimated cost
- If we don't make more money we will have \$2,600 remaining from the year

### 3. GRANDPARENTS' TEA

- +100 grandparents showed up and turned out to be a great show
- \$195 for ticket sales earned from the gift baskets
- \$75 should come in more that was not tracked yet

### 4. LUNCHES

- Sourcing Greek vendor for FY19-FY20 lunches
- \$4.85 per lunch with no taxes charged for cost, this vendor is experienced serving Sir John. A Macdonald
- Sub and Pasta are proposing for changes in FY19-FY20 school year, but not larger amounts where we will increase selling price

- Sub increased to \$5.75 sale price; Pasta increased to \$5.50
- Swiss Chalet has a school program, \$6.50 costs for quarter chicken and \$5.50 for chicken strips
- Swiss Chalet will replace Pita Lunch
- Astoria will replace Mr. Greek (Chicken, spinach, pita wraps)

- Food truck will come at 4pm; ice cream coming at 4:45pm
