1. INTRODUCTION & SCHOOL NEWS

- Minutes of last meeting on Oct 17th, 2018 were approved.
- School Climate Survey on Grades 5-8 students data indicated that > 59% students felt they needed to be perfect
- Focus would be the underserve for those who felt they were not performing
- Wellness Family night planned to be end of Feb 2019 to help share resources for those special in needs
- Principal Asha Rathod shared recent school news, sound system fully implemented and will be training Gr. 6 to use it
- Parent workshop to assist Private School and immigrants to help parents understand their report cards

2. FINANCE & TREASURERS REPORT

- Shankeetha covered Treasurers' report and FY18/FY19 school year will trend at approx.
 \$1k more than last year for investment in education
- Extreme Pita overcharged \$50/month as expenses but that has been subsequently corrected
- If we don't generate anymore income, we will be profit of \$5k (before taking \$5,000 for cost sharing)

3. LUNCHES

- Lowell provided updates on sales and data for school lunches
- Pasta lunch prices will go up for the next school year but determined to be reasonable
- Greek lunches are ~\$6.50 with the juice box which seems on the pricier side, we will plan to source another supplier in replacement next year
- Sushi lunch contained plastic wrapping in one of the kids' lunch, Mine sushi apologized with no accidents and the family did not escalate further.

4. COOKIES AND POPCORN

Gross income was \$276 for month of November

- Flyers were put up throughout the school to advertise
- Holiday cookies will be next month in the shape of a gingerbread man

5. FUNDRAISING PLAN

- Indigo Fundraiser: planning to be 5:15pm set up and the band will be there
- The event will start at 6pm, the band will be in the front near Starbucks area
- Giftcards and sales item are included along with the plum rewards this year
- A flyer is needed in order to donate the 15% to the school (digital copies allowed)
- Book wall for the school, parents can purchase books to donate to the school and benefiting the 15% given back to the school simultaneously
- Chairs will be delivered by Imma and Neely, 12 students will bring their music stands direction from home to Indigo
- Ms. Frolic and Ms. Zwarich will support set up and delivery as well with the help of other students

6. LOGO WEAR

- Imma shared updates on spirit wear for the school with samples from ATC and Under Amour samples, logo was settled on a subtle one on the arm
- Plans to charge ~\$5/pc profit on top of the cost
- Under Armor Youth \$24.95, Shorts \$26.95
- Under Armor Youth Pants \$37.95, Hoodie \$37.95
- ATC Youth \$29.95 + \$5 logo fee, Sweatpants \$19.90
- ATC T-shirt \$12.95, Youth pants \$15.95
- Council plans to proceed with cheaper brands for the shorts and sweaters with Under Armor for better durability & quality
- Council plans to charge \$49.97 for sweaters with approx. \$5 profit
- School cash online prices will be inclusive of all HST, profit, and logo.

- We do it 2x a year and hand out hot chocolate to give back to the school
- Volunteers for hot chocolate required

8. WINTER CONCERT ON DEC 13TH

- Volunteers for Spirit Wear and snack table are required
