#### 1. Introduction

### 2. School Council Updates

- a) Treasurer's Report
  - Opening balance same as last report
  - Lunches were offered starting 2<sup>nd</sup> week of Oct
  - \$175 collected from the Buffs/water bottle sales
  - Both of the above will be reflected in next months financial statements
- b) Hot Lunches
  - Great success burgers are a big hit!
    - o Greek: 104 orders
    - Pizza: 279 orders
    - Sub: 84 orders
  - Extend current vendors until start of March break
  - Brainstorming ideas of potential new vendors:
    - Tasty Ya (new) not interested in joining the Happy Hunger platform
    - o Ellyn Waldman to provide contact for Ambiyan Indian restaurant on Main Street
    - Currently Monday and Friday open to secure new vendors

### 3. Fundraising Initiatives

- a) Indigo Night paused due to vendor not offering these initiatives
- b) Proposed sale of **Poinsettias** as part of holiday spirit company based out of Bradford
  - Can order on School cash online
  - Orders have to be in by November 25<sup>th</sup> and last delivery date is November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022 (Council voted last order date as November 22<sup>nd</sup>)

Free delivery offered with a minimum order of \$750 Sizes offered:

- 4.5 in. (cost \$3.55 plus HST = \$4.01) Council voted <u>YES</u> for \$8 (final price) after profit
- 6 in. (cost \$6.25 plus HST = \$7.06) Council voted <u>YES</u> for \$10 (final price) after profit
- 8 in. (cost \$13) Council voted NO

• 10 in. (\$19.50) – *voted Yes over email* for \$30 (final price)

Family Festive Night - Thursday, Dec 1st

- Parents to pick-up poinsettias from school
- Popcorn cash
  - Finalized over email:
    - 200 bags of popcorn in 3 flavours (Low-fat caramel, Butter flavour and White cheddar flavour)
    - 80 cups of hot chocolate (one coffee urn full) which requires 1.5 cans of carnation hot chocolate

- o Mitts and hats
- Have choir perform
- c) Buttonville gift bags made by BPS students will be sold in December
- d) Big Box Fundraising (Council voted YES) presented by Connie Yu
  - Free delivery with no minimum requirements
  - Can sell for a box of 35 cards for \$35 (cost is \$24)
  - Will gather more information on start date/finish date/link with information on cards)
- e) Northern Karate Lunch Program (Council voted YES) presented by Connie Yu
  - Non-contact karate program for students offered once a week for 4 to 6 weeks during lunch recess (Northern Karate cannot do Wednesdays)
  - No minimum requirement
  - Northern Karate will send flyers to parents and sign-up kids who are interested
  - Cost:
    - 4 weeks (\$39 plus HST) 100% of profits go to school
    - $\circ~~$  6 (\$59 plus HST) 100% of profits go to school
  - Each class is 30 to 40 minutes
  - If a child class misses a class, they offer a free class at their dojo
  - Proposing to offer classes in the Library
  - After the last class, a graduation ceremony is done at the dojo where parents are invited to get more information on the program
  - Next steps:
    - $\circ$  Northern Karate to assess library and maximum number of students per session
    - Depending on interest level, willing to offer multiple days of the week

- b) Moving with a partnership with an indigenous artist

- Each group of immediate students will make a large canvas combine the collaboration part of it with the indigenous perspective
- Mobile art gallery showcase art at different areas
- c) Parent-Teacher Interviews Thursday, November 17 (evening) and Friday, November 18 (morning) will open schedule
- d) Professional development update staff going through a 4C process co-teach and co-mark the lessons
- e) School preparing for Remember Day
- f) Grade 8 Grad Trip students voted to go to Ottawa
- g) EQAO results were shared for Grade 3 and Grade 6 next steps: analyze and look for patterns on how to improve
