
We look forward to seeing many of our families at our upcoming Spring Concert on April 24th.

MILK BAG WEAVING INITIATIVE

Cedarwood students have been actively involved in Milk Bag Weaving! To date, we have collected over 1600 milk bags! By recycling these milk bags, not only are we reducing our waste, we are also helping countries in need. The bags are woven into mats (it takes 600 milk bags to create one mat) for people to sleep on and are sent to developing nations most in need.
