CLASS REORGANIZATION

As you may be aware, schools across Ontario are implementing many changes to support our commitment to ensuring a safe, caring and robust learning environment for all students. As a result, the York Region District School Board recently reopened a survey to families, allowing them to request a transfer from Face-to-Face to Virtual and vice versa. This is the final survey for Term 1. As a result, our school is reorganizing classes to account for the movement of students and teachers. By the end of this week your child(ren)might receive a notice of a teacher and/or class change.

All class placement changes, whether from virtual to face-to-face or face-to-face to virtual or a move between classrooms/teachers onsite will be finalized on Friday. All students will be in their new schools or classes for a fresh start on Monday, October, 5th, 2020.

We continue to work with our Elementary Virtual School partners to ensure the successful transition of our students. We thank you for your patience throughout this process.
