World Down Syndrome Day (WDSD), March 21st, is a global awareness day which has been officially observed by the United Nations since 2012. The Province of Ontario has proclaimed March 21st as Ontario Down Syndrome Day, since 2016. The date for WDSD being the 21st day of the 3rd month was selected to signify the uniqueness of the triplication (trisomy) of the 21st chromosome which causes Down syndrome. For the last few years, the DSAYR has been promoting the awareness of the ABILITIES of people with Down syndrome within our school system. Classes will engage in virtual learning activities that have been prepared to support learning about the ABILITIES of people with Down syndrome.




HIGH-LIGHTING STUDENT WORK


