

SAFETY PROTOCOLS REMINDERS

1) All students in Grades 4-8 need to wear a mask at all times while at school **and** outside when they cannot maintain a 2m distance.

2) Students are asked to go directly home from school. If they cannot maintain the 2m distance, while outside they should be wearing a mask. Parents please remind your children to be extra vigilant with safety measures afterschool when leaving school property and walking home.

3) We are asking family members while on school property to please wear a mask.

4) Please remember to screen your child(ren) everyday before coming to school. If you have any of the symptoms on the screening checklist, your child(ren) should remain at home.

CAR SEAT REMINDERS

The province's Highway Traffic Act allows children weighing 9 kg to 18 kg (20 to 40 lb) to use a forward-facing child car seat or a rear-facing car seat as long as the car seat manufacturer recommends its use.

Booster seats are required for children weighing 18 kg to 36 kg (40 to 80 lb), stand less than 1.45 m (4'9") tall and who are under the age of eight.


Please also be reminded that children need to be properly fastened in their car seats even if it is a short drive to school.
