Dear Grade 8 Families,

The purpose of this letter is to provide you with an update regarding the **Grade 8 Graduation Celebration** that is scheduled to take place on the evening of **Wednesday**, **June 24**, **2020** following the graduation ceremony that will be held in the gymnasium of Sir William Mulock Secondary School.

This fall, a committee was created consisting of parent volunteers. The committee, in consultation with the Clearmeadow administrative team and Grade 8 teachers, is working to plan and raise funds for a memorable, age-appropriate celebration for our graduates. To date, we have secured **Cardinal Golf and Country Club** as our venue. Students will mingle, dance, enjoy a delicious meal and desserts, and have a fun night with their peers. More detailed communication about the event will be sent home in early May. At that time, we will also request information regarding any cultural and/or dietary accommodations your son or daughter may require to ensure a safe and enjoyable evening. **The anticipated cost per ticket will be \$25.00.**

It is important to everyone involved that the Grade 8 students actively engage in the fundraising process. Since mid-January, we have started a **Kernels Popcorn Fundraiser**. Each Thursday, students take turns volunteering and assist with a variety of jobs including making morning announcements, taking orders and making special deliveries to our kindergarten students, and counting money. Grade 8 parent, Ms. Mellissa Ruscio has spearheaded this initiative and is very kindly volunteering her time each week to work with the students.

Another way for our students to get involved is through the **Celebrity Server Program** at **Boston Pizza**. We have secured two dates for our students to volunteer: **Wednesday, March 25** and **Wednesday, April 22**. Please speak with your son or daughter about getting involved. Beyond helping to support the event, this is a great opportunity for your child to get a taste of what is involved in having a part-time job in the service industry. If your child cannot volunteer, we hope that you, your family, friends, and other Clearmeadow families might make a reservation and join us for a meal at Boston Pizza. 10% of food sales will be donated to our graduation celebration.

The celebrity server event runs between 5:00 and 8:00 p.m. Our first "wave" of students should arrive by 4:45. Our second "wave" will arrive at 6:15 and they will be replacing the first group of students on the floor.
