During the day on Friday, teachers will be supporting the transition by preparing students for a move on Monday, if they will have a new class placement.

Changes at our school will be effective Monday, October 5, 2020. For students moving from Face to Face to the virtual schools (EVS) this move will be effective Monday October 5th. Additional details about the transition will be shared by EVS staff by **Friday October 2nd**.

Thank you for your support as some students transition to a new learning environment. We wish everyone continued good health and well-being, as we move forward with this shift across our face-to-face and virtual learning models.
