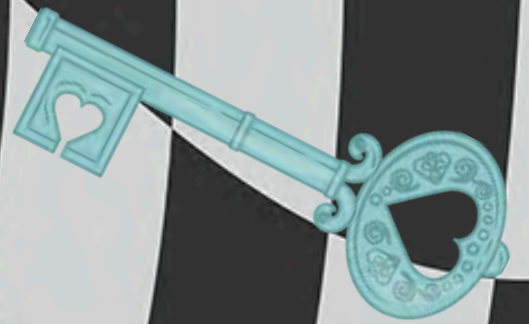
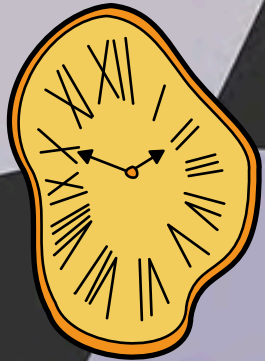
Tickets for our **Alice in Wonderland Jr. Musical** on **Wednesday, April 16th at 7:00 pm** are available on School Cash Online until April 14.
