The team meets weekly to practice and prepare for upcoming competitions against other schools. It's a fantastic opportunity for students to challenge their minds, work as a team, and have fun!





For Those who Qualify

York Region is offering the Transit Assistance Program (TAP) to help make transit more affordable for eligible residents.

- ➤ Eligible TAP participants can receive a 50% discount on regular Adult single ride York Region Transit (YRT) fare using a PRESTO card. After 40 trips, rides are free for unlimited travel for the remainder of the calendar month.
- > Anyone in the family can use the TAP card, including students going to high school
