World Down Syndrome Day - March 21

World Down Syndrome Day is on 21 March every year. It is a global awareness day which has been officially observed by the United Nations since 2012. The goal is to help people understand and support those with Down syndrome better.

The date being the 21st day of the 3rd month was chosen to represent the triplication (trisomy) of the 21st chromosome which causes Down syndrome.

Today, we had "Lots of Socks" day at Cornell. Students and staff wore mismatched socks or their boldest and most colourful socks!

The idea was to start a conversation, so when people ask them about their socks, they can tell them, "I'm wearing them to raise awareness of Down syndrome". Then, they can tell them everything they want them to know about Down syndrome.

Is Your Child Not Feeling Well?

Although Spring has officially arrived, we would like to continue to remind families about the following information that can also be found on the Public Health website (https://www.ontario.ca/page/protection-covid-19-and-other-respiratory-illnesses):

- If your child is sick, stay home to prevent transmission to others, except to seek testing or medical care if required.
- Your child should stay home until **all** of the following apply to them:
 - symptoms have been improving for at least 24 hours (or 48 hours if you had nausea, vomiting and/or diarrhea, i.e. from the last time that they had any symptoms)
 - o they do not have a fever
 - o they do not develop any additional symptoms




