Dear Families,

As the weather turns colder, it is important to ensure that all of our students are dressed for the changing conditions. We recommend that students have winter boots, snow pants, a winter jacket, waterproof gloves/mittens, a hat and scarf. Dressing in layers is always a good idea. We also suggest a change of clothes (including socks), in case your child gets wet.

We recognize that outfitting a child for winter gear can be expensive. If you need support with obtaining winter clothing, please reach out to Mrs. Purcell or Ms. Trim. We always have items available in the office and starting this year, we will be offering the opportunity for families to "shop" for gently used items at our school. Please see the letter sent home that outlines our plan for a pantry and clothing swap. We are accepting clothing during the week of December 2nd to December 6th. Starting December 9th, any CVPS families are invited to choose any items from our Winter Clothing tables (located in the front foyer). The clothing tables will be open from 8:15 to 8:45 am and 3:30 to 4:00 pm each day that week. If not able to come to the school during these times, but would like items set aside, that can be arranged. On December 19th, any remaining items will be donated to local charities.


