6) School Council Forum Session Update

- Sarah Y attended the Authentic Family Engagement session. Four pillars - inform (eg. Cobra News), consult (eg. Council Meetings), involve (eg. Volunteers in the school), collaborate (eg. Parent night, family night, etc.)


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- Joanne attended a literacy session called "Supporting Literacy Learning at Home" (reference PPT will be shared) and a session about fundraising (reference PPT will be shared)
- Wendy attended a session called "How to support math at home" led by a familiar face, Mr. Scott Chin (reference deck to be shared). This could be a good session to share more broadly with parents - stay tuned.

7) New Business (5 mins)

a. Wendy - Field Trips

- Parents wondering how trips are selected, ensuring equitable across all of the grades
- School Admin does their best to ensure all grades have opportunity for various field trips but many factors contribute to what can be planned (eg. cost, transportation, availability...)
- For example:
- Swimming - we have signed up but our school has not yet been selected
- Skiing - higher risk of accident so not encouraged
- Busing is very expensive (supply/demand issue) and timing is a problem

8) School Council Survey - Results/Discussion (45 mins)

- 13 responses received out of 16; Joanne/Heather shared aggregate results of the survey
- Overall as a Council we are performing well with room for improvement in a few areas
- Example - perhaps there are language/childcare barriers to providing equitable access to Council meetings
- Could be addressed via offering translation services and/or babysitting for meetings if needed
- Could set up an email address where parents, guardians and community members can reach Council members
- Council by-laws (constitution) should reviewed to ensure that they are aligned with the new policy revisions
- Some comments were provided from those in attendance virtually:
- Should we consider a survey for CVPS parents/guardians to seek opinions/perceptions; after a period of time, we could survey again to see if there has been any improvements
- Do we need a more robust communication strategy to communicate what Council does for the school, for parents/guardians, etc.? To be discussed further...takeaway for the Communications Committee
- Deck to be shared with Council members to review in more detail

9) Committee Updates/Discussions (30 mins)
a. Communications

b. Parent Engagement
- Committee considering a combination event like Movie Night or Games Night with a Parent Engagement Activity but requires staff/volunteer support for another movie night or activity where kids need to be watched

- Social skills building


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- Academic/math achievement (Wendy/Scott Chin at no/low cost)
- Language/literacy curriculum - understand and support
- Interactive with arts/music
- Internet safety - guest speaker (eg. Paul Davis)
- Council suggested we send a survey to parents/guardians with options and ask them to rank (not vote) options; survey to possibly include:
- Preference for in person/virtual, days of the week, time of day
- Language support requirements
- Child minding requirements
c. Staff Appreciation
- Halloween treats provided for all staff
- PA day coffee/tea \& breakfast treats to be provided for next PA day (Nov 17)
- Thank you to everyone who contributed at their own expense!
d. Sustainability
- Working on boxes for writing utensil recycling boxes; should be implemented soon and will be communicated via Cobra News
