## **Exams**

January 25<sup>th</sup> to January 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018 Exam Review Day February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018

Exams are an important part of the final assessment that occurs in January. Semester one exams run from January 25 – January 31, 2017 inclusive. February 1st is Exam Review Day. Examinations are written on a "Period-by-Period" schedule as follows:

January 25 - Period 1 courses

January 26 - Period 2 courses

January 29 – Period 3 courses

January 30 - Period 4 courses

All exams begin at 9:00 a.m. and most are complete by 10:30 a.m. Some senior exams are 2 hours in length and performance exams are scheduled on an individual basis with the teacher. Please plan holidays around the examination dates. All examinations must be written on the specific date and time and in the location as scheduled. They will not be rescheduled for individual students. The ONLY exceptions to this will be for ILLNESS, COURT APPEARANCE, or BEREAVEMENT, and proper documentation will be required. Students who miss an examination without such documentation will receive a mark of zero for the examination portion of their final mark.

## **Grade 9 EQAO Math Assessment**

Our Grade 9 students currently in Math classes will write the EQAO Math tests on **January 17 & 18, 2018**. The Grade 9 Assessment of Mathematics measures how well students have met the expectations in the Grade 9 Mathematics curriculum for Applied and Academic courses. Student achievement in this assessment is reported using a four-level scale that is aligned with the scale used in The Ontario Curriculum, Grades 9 and 10: Mathematics and the Provincial Report Card, Grades 9-12, In the Ontario Curriculum. The results from this assessment provide baseline information that will assist in board and school improvement planning. Letters outlining test dates will be sent home on December 5th. The students' results on the test comprise 5% of the students' final mark in Math.

Any student considering a **semester 2 timetable change** should book a Guidance appointment ASAP! Come in and talk about pathways and courses before the semester starts to avoid delays and missing any new classes!
