Summer School Information:

- <u>Summer School Day school</u> is open for registration. Students log on to their course planner on My Pathway Planner, and click on Con-ed to choose their course.
- Acceleration courses are the full month of July and are for students that are taking a new course, or were NOT recommended by the teacher/student success team for a 2 week reinforcement course if they were unsuccessful in a course.
- Full courses run from July 3 July 26th.
- <u>Summer School elearning</u> (online courses) are also available for selected courses. Student can sign up on the <u>www.yrdsb.ca</u> website and continue to the "Programs and Services" tab across the top bar, and then to Summer School elearning.
- Admission Information Service (AIS) Are you an Ontario high school student applying to an Ontario university and <u>have not received an offer of admission</u>? Starting June 6, 2019, you can use the AIS to find possible openings at other Ontario universities. Requirements: You must have completed the OSSD (or equivalent), including six 4U/M courses, by early September 2019.
