January 24th to January 30th Evaluation Review Day January 31st

Exams are an important part of the final assessment that occurs in January. Semester one exams run from January 24 – January 30, 2019, inclusive. January 31st is Evaluation Review Day.

January 24 – Period 1 courses January 25 – Period 2 courses January 28 – Period 3 courses January 29 – Period 4 courses

All exams begin at 9:00 a.m. and most are complete by 10:30 a.m. Some senior exams are 2 hours in length and performance exams are scheduled on an individual basis with the teacher. Please plan holidays around the examination dates. All examinations must be written on the specific date and time and in the location as scheduled. They will not be rescheduled for individual students. The ONLY exceptions to this will be for ILLNESS, COURT APPEARANCE, or BEREAVEMENT, and proper documentation will be required. Students who miss an examination without such documentation will receive a mark of zero for the examination portion of their final mark

Grade 9 EOAO Math Assessment

Our Grade 9 students currently in Math classes will write the EQAO Math tests on January 15 & 16, 2019. The Grade 9 Assessment of Mathematics measures how well students have met the expectations in the Grade 9 Mathematics curriculum for Applied and Academic courses. Student achievement in this assessment is reported using a four-level scale that is aligned with the scale used in The Ontario Curriculum, Grades 9 and 10: Mathematics and the Provincial Report Card, Grades 9-12, In the Ontario Curriculum. The results from this assessment provide baseline information that will assist in board and school improvement planning. Letters outlining test dates will be sent home on December 10th. The students' results on the test comprise 5% of the students' final mark in Math.
