#2 - WHAT IS THE ROLE OF THE COUNCIL?

- The Council provides advice on the following areas:
- Advisory
 - School improvement planning, school-based services and community partnerships, budget priorities, principal profile, local school calendar, use of school facilities, etc.
- Outreach Activities
 - Developing a sense of community, communication strategies, workshops/seminars, planning/fundraising for extra-curriculars, etc.

#3 - WHO SITS ON THE COUNCIL?

- Councils are comprised of parents, the principal, one teacher, one admin/support staff , at least one community rep and a student (where appropriate).
 - ~~Elementary - 9 members, at least 5 parents~~
 - Secondary - 11 members, at least 6 parents
 - Members are elected annually in September.

#4 ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- **Chair/Co-Chair:** Calls & chairs meetings; sets agendas works collaboratively with members to assign duties
- **Vice-Chair:** Supports and assists the Chair
- **Treasurer:** Manages finances, reports monthly on accounts
- **Secretary:** Prepares agendas and minutes
- **Members:** Participate and encourage participation
