- **Aurora Lions Club Award** goes to the Aurora student who has demonstrated noticeable in-school and academic growth and is furthering his or her education.
- **B + B Dixon Auto Award** is given to the graduating student(s) with a high level of practical performance, work ethics and academics in transportation technology.
- **District 16 Ontario Secondary School Teachers' Federation Scholarship** is awarded to a graduate who has obtained a high overall average in his or her graduating year and is attending a community college program.
- **The Dr. G. W. Williams S.S. Citizenship Award** is given to the graduating student who has made positive contributions to the school community during their tenure at Williams.
- **The Doug Atkinson Memorial Award** is presented to the graduating student who has shown great perseverance.
- **Jim Butcher Jr. Memorial Scholarship** is presented to the top graduating student continuing in the automotive industry, either in college or through an apprenticeship.
- **Johnson Financial Group Education Achievement Scholarship** is awarded to the student who has demonstrated significant academic improvement throughout high school.
- **Karen Reichardt Memorial Scholarship** is presented to the student who has demonstrated high academics and is pursuing a university education in food and nutrition or health related studies.
- **Lenard H. Lind Outstanding Business Awards** are given to the graduating students who have completed business courses with high success and are continuing their post-secondary studies.
- **Lieutenant Governor's Community Volunteer Award** recognizes a graduating student who has demonstrated exemplary involvement in the community over four years of secondary school.
- **Norm Weller Award** goes to the student who has exhibited a high academic standard as well as an interest in the preservation and study of the natural environment.
- **Rotary Club of Aurora Arts Award** is presented to the graduate who successfully completed two or more senior Art courses, or who has developed their own style and is pursuing further education.
- **Rotary Club of Aurora History Award** goes to the graduating student who is most accomplished in two senior History courses and who is pursuing further education.
- **Rotary Club of Aurora Music Award** is given to the student with exceptional talent and dedication to the music program and who is pursuing further education.
- **Russell Family Special Education Award** is presented by the Russell family each year in honour of a student who has significantly benefited from, and contributed to, the Special Education program at Williams. The award recognizes a student who has achieved personal success.
- **Senior Omega Award** is in its 16th year of existence. The name "Omega" is used because it is the letter in the Greek alphabet that corresponds to "W" as in Williams. It is also the last letter, and as such, means completion, and thereby represents the culmination of a well-rounded school year. The award is given to students who excel in three main areas of school life: academics, athletics and club activities. A student's involvement is translated into points.
