If you are driving your child to school, please use the Kiss'n Ride loop. Please be patient, drive slowly and be careful. The Kiss'n Ride is for drop off only, not parking. Please remember, there is no parking or stopping on the North side of Larkin.

Part of our job is to keep your children <u>safe and alive</u>. We are trying to teach the students to cross the road at a designated intersection with the crossing guard. Please be a good role model for your child and do not cross Larkin without the help of the crossing guard. The Crossing Guards are located at Larkin Ave. and Fincham Ave. and on Larkin Ave. and Heisey Dr. Crossing guards are on duty in the morning and after school.

Please remember: the best way to get to school... is to walk!

For Children:

- · Try to walk with others whenever possible

For Parents:

- · Review street-proofing tips with your children on an on-going basis
- · Make sure you know the route they take to and from school
- · Try to arrange for them to walk with a friend
- · Ensure your children wear reflective clothing if travelling in the dark

For Drivers:

· Slow down and drive with care. Imagine a child darting in front of your car and ask yourself this:

Would I be able to stop if I had to?

- · Give children the right-of-way at crosswalks and intersections and obey the direction of crossing guards
- · Pay attention to school bus signals and stop arms.


