

# Ascending Sisters Pilot Project:

Elder's Mills is pleased to announce that it is one of the schools piloting the Ascending Sisters Mentorship Program. In alignment with the Dismantling Anti-Black Racism Strategy, Ascending Sisters serves as a mentorship program that connects Black girls and non binary students with self-identified Black YRDSB staff (e.g., teachers, educational assistants, Child and Youth workers, support professionals, administrators). Cisgender girls, transgender girls and non binary students from **grades 7-10 in selected pilot schools** are all welcome to participate. Through targeted wellness, health and mentorship opportunities, students will be provided with the opportunity to develop a stronger sense of self, promote healing, increase ability to advocate, communicate effectively and further enhance their leadership skills.




