

#### MESSAGES FROM THE OFFICE

#### Attendance and Safe Arrival:

Parents may inform the school office of their child's absence in three different ways:

- 1. Absences can be entered into **Edsby** which is available 24 hours/day, 7 days a week. Future absences can be reported at any time;
- 2. Send an email to the school attendance email address at: lders.mills.ps.attendance@yrdsb.ca;
- 3. Parents may choose to contact the school office at 905-893-1631 between 8:30 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. on the day of absence.

We continue to have to respond to a high number of unreported absences and lates. Please ensure you make every effort to communicate with the school if your child will be away or arriving after 8:45 a.m. If Edsby is not available (we recognize this may sometimes happen), please use one of the other two methods above to report the absence. When the school cannot confirm a child's absence, we do need to follow our Safe arrival procedures and this may include reaching out to York Regional Police to help locate and ensure the safety of your child. We appreciate your cooperation in this matter.
