Carr from November 29 to December 2, 2022. All eligible grade 10s will write as well as any grade 11 and non-graduating grade 12 students who did not participate in or were not successful in the 2021-2022 administration.

SCHOOL IMMUNIZATIONS

York Region Public Health is offering an immunization clinic at your child's school for Hepatitis B, HPV & Meningococcal vaccines. Vaccines are available for free to students in grades 7-12. The Scheduled clinic day is Thursday December 1st in the conference room next to the main office.

If your child was vaccinated at a YRPH public health catch up clinic (in 2021 or earlier in 2022) please submit a new consent form to ensure they can be immunized at school.
