



## **STEPS TO BUYING AN HPE UNIFORM FOR PE CLASS:**

1. Go to <u>schoolcashonline.com</u> and create an account if you don't already have one (students from YRDSB feeder schools should already have an account).

## 2. ORDER YOUR UNIFORM

The HPE uniform at ECSS includes wearing the ECSS top and bottoms which can be any combination of:

- ECSS PE uniform shorts (black)
- ECSS PE uniform T-Shirt (black)
- ECSS PE uniform hoodie (gray or black)
- ECSS PE uniform sweatpants (gray or black)

\*\*NOTE: don't worry about sizing because you will pick up your uniform in person and we will size you at that time.\*\*

## **3. PICK UP**

Once your uniform has been purchased you may print your receipt (or take a screenshot) and bring it with you to the school to pick up your uniform.

Please come to the HPE office (room 136) and show your receipt to the staff member who answers the door.

Together you can choose the correct size for you.






Prices may change from year to year depending upon our supplier.

Currently the uniform prices are (2022-23):

- T-Shirt \$11
- Shorts \$16
- Hoodie \$29
- Sweatpants \$24
- OR
- Uniform Package Deal (2 t-shirts, 1 pair of shorts) \$35

## **OTHER INFORMATION**

- You may buy and pick up a uniform at any time during any school year, as we stock them in our school, they are always available (unless we have to order more, but then we will).
- The uniform colours change sometimes but right now they are:
  - Black T-shirt with white ECSS logo front and centre
  - Black Shorts no logo (basketball style or shorter style)
  - Black Sweatpants with white logo front left leg
  - Slack Hoodie with white logo front and centre





### Indigenous Languages and International Languages - Secondary Credit Programs

Dear Students and Families,

We welcome everyone to the 2022-2023 Indigenous Languages and International Languages (ILIL) program year and thank you for your continued support and patience.

During the pandemic, enrolment in the ILIL Credit program grew when compared to previous years. As a result, the program will remain in an online (remote) format. The program will be delivered virtually through synchronous learning, supported by asynchronous activities. Teachers will teach live language lessons in real time using Google Classroom to provide both synchronous and asynchronous learning opportunities during the regularly scheduled language classes. All program updates will be made on our <u>Board ILIL program homepage</u>.

#### Did you know there are many benefits to taking credit language courses?

- Students can take one International Languages Course as a Group 1 Compulsory or as an Elective Credit towards their Ontario Secondary Diploma.
- Students in the Secondary International Languages program can earn up to three credits towards graduation.
- If students earn a credit in the Level D (university) course, it can be used as one of their top six (6) marks for
  post-secondary entry. For example, if a student takes Spanish Level B, C and D, the student can submit their
  Level D mark as one of the top six marks for post-secondary applications.

#### Already Registered?

If you have already registered for our fall programs, we thank you. Your registration will be moved to the same day on the online Site. No further action is required (e.g., if you originally registered for Greek for Richmond Hill H.S. then you will be automatically moved to the Saturday ILIL Online Site).

#### Secondary Program Registration

- Credit classes begin September 24, 2022. Secondary (Grades 9 to 12) ILIL registration will not be accepted after the third class. Refer to our <u>ILIL Secondary Credit Program</u> webpage for the most up-to-date information about class start dates and times.

  - Please register on <u>myPathway Planner</u> before September 19, 2022.

  - After September 19, please complete the online <u>Registration Form</u>. Once submitted, a confirmation form will be emailed to the student.
