Carefully read the guide and note that the 'Consent Form' and 'Elements of Risk' sections need to be detached, completed and returned to your child's period two teacher on Tuesday, November 6. 
GUIDANCE AND CAREER EDUCATION

The PATHWAYS TO OPPORTUNITY evening is taking place on **Thursday, November 15**th **from 6:30 p.m. - 8:30 p.m.** This is an event where students and their parents/guardians have an opportunity to meet with representatives from various universities and colleges, as well as numerous other post-secondary institutions, in order to learn more about the different programs they offer.

The 40 hours of Community Involvement is a Ministry of Education diploma requirement without which an Ontario Secondary School Diploma cannot be issued.
